WELCOME TO THE SUMMER READING PROGRAM '09

This year we are happy to bring you several book lists and forms to enhance your child's summer reading experience. Gleaning material from bookstores and librarian websites we present suggestions to stimulate your child's reading and to broaden reading choices.

Please encourage your students to read each day in order to strengthen their skills and to help them grow into recreational readers. The world is theirs to discover when they open a book.

Our goal is to have every student read at least 6 books and read for at least 6 hours (360 minutes) this summer. There is a sheet enclosed for your child to keep a log of each reading session and to record the book and author. Encourage your children to vary the kinds of books they read so they learn what books can offer them.

The youngest readers can start on the path to a lifetime of reading with the experiences they have at a library story hour or a bedtime story telling routine. Use this summer to help them learn to love reading.

Again, we urge your children to read and take part in our program as well as any community reading programs. Have them turn in the lists they have kept from any one of the summer reading clubs in which they have participated and we will count it towards the Epstein program for prizes and certificates.
