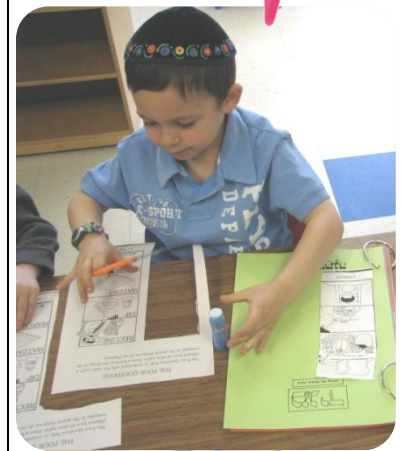
## Pre-K Potpourri
